Uh... I missed that. Would you mind REPEATING that for me, please?








Meanwhile, Dr. DeCov has recurring nightmares about "remember"—Sprok's mentally transmitted message....


Then, of course, they battle it out for Sprok's brain as well as his bod! In the special 3-D, the audience is REALLY involved in the action...



Of course, the battle ends as Ambassador Sawarek negotiates a peace!




Look, fellas, grow up, huh? I'm sick and tired of you turkeys always fighting all the time. Now we either have peace now, or I'll put you both over my knees!




And now, Lenny Maltliquor will review STAR TRIP 3-D!
